Marshal Report: Incident report for March 2026 was presented. The radar sign on SR14 by Noyer Drive will be replaced this week with the help of the street department. The license for the body cams has been updated, and the software seems to be functioning properly.

Superintendent Report:

Water Dept: We completed 4 data log reports. Thomas Excavating is close to completion on the new water main on SR19. They must complete 1 tap. Still waiting for an update from Ascher on when they will resume work on the South Water Tower. The water department is planning to flush fire hydrants next week weather permitting.

Sewer Dept: A drainage tile near 403 W Rochester Street needs repaired.

Street Dept: The start date for the concrete repair by Dilly's was pushed back due to the significant rainfall with hopes to start the week of April 20th. The CCMG pre-construction meeting has been held. DC Construction plans to start the concrete portion of the project on Thursday, April 23rd.

Miscellaneous: We completed 48 locate tickets over the last month. This increase is due to Frontier's fiber upgrade project. AR Tree Service has completed the tree removal necessary for the CCMG project to begin. The park restrooms are open for the season. The tornado siren repair/replacement has been denied by insurance. Jim made a motion to approve the quote from Federal Signal for \$37,017. Tony 2nd. 2 ayes.

Attorney Report:

Tony made a motion to approve Dockets for \$148,130.48. Jim 2nd. 2 ayes.


Tony made a motion to approve the Payroll Allowance Docket for \$29,987.56. Jim 2nd. 2 ayes.
